MINUTES

Thursday, December 1, 2016 - 7:30 p.m. Flynn Building, Silva Conference Room 278 Old Sudbury Road, Sudbury, MA 01776

New Business:

Public Hearing – Case 16-26, Applicants Joyce and Douglas Arthur, 229 Peakham Road (Town Assessor's Map J05-0330). For a Certificate of Appropriateness to expand size of existing front landing and steps, to build a portico and to replace a window.

After discussion, members unanimously approved plans for a portico and window replacement as shown with the following conditions:

- The front door will be a six panel wood door with two or three lights. The door will be painted forest green or charcoal.
- All renovations and additions will be painted to match existing colors except the door.

CONTINUATION - Public Hearing – Case 14-21: Applicant Jeffrey Walker, Walker Development, 197 Lot A and 197 Lot B Old Sudbury Road (Town Assessor's Map H10-0006). For a Certificate of Appropriateness to build two new residences.

After discussion, members unanimously approved the following revisions to lots 197A and B.

Lot A:

- The front door will be a six-panel front door as shown in the materials presented.
- The farmer's porch will have a 9 light door as shown.
- Tumbled brick will be used for the chimney.

Lot B:

- Asbestos shingles matching the rest of the roof will be used on the left dormer.
- The colors of the house will be Hardie Board Navaho Beige for the body; Autumn Tan for the trim; a forest/dark green for the six panel front door; and bronze for the standing seam metal roof.

Other Business:

The Commission answered questions for Jessica and Griff Noble, 47 Concord Road, who
would like to replace their driveway. The Noble's will make application for a certificate
of appropriateness.
