## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING April 6, 2009

The SHA met in open session LSRHS cafeteria in Sudbury, at 7:15 p.m. Those present were: Chairperson: Sherrill Cline; Vice Chair: Lydia Pastuszek; Treasurer: DeBorah Sonnenschein: Member: Kaffee Kang; Associate Members: Sheila Cusolito and Judith Deutsch; Executive Director: Jo-Ann Howe.

**1. MINUTES:** A motion to <u>approve the minutes of the meeting of March 10, 2009</u> was made by K. Kang, seconded by D. Sonnenschein, and unanimously approved.

**2. CHECKS:** A motion to <u>approve the checks written in March</u> was made by L. Pastuszek, seconded by K. Kang, and unanimously approved.

## **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

**3. Redevelopment Project:** Additional comments from the SHA on design issues were submitted to architect Carol Burns on 3/24. The Consultant Selection Committee met on 3/17 and 3/26 and interviewed and ranked the following consulting firms after having checked references and before opening bids: MHJ, New England Communities, Inc., and the Women's Institute. The Women's Institute was unanimously selected based on the applicability of its previous work, its presentation and its references. A motion was made by Lydia Pastuszek, seconded by K. Kang and unanimously <u>approved to hire the Women's Institute as consultants for the redevelopment project, contingent on successful fee negotiations</u>.

**<u>4. Contract Authorization</u>**: A motion was made by K. Kang, seconded by D. Sonnenschein, and unanimously <u>approved to authorize J. Howe to execute a contract with the selected consultant, the Women's Institute</u>.

<u>Condo Development</u>: S. Cline reported that the SHA's attorney, Dan Burger, believes that the Declaration of Trust can be amended to comply with DHCD regulations and will prepare a proposed amendment, which will cost the SHA about \$450 for filing, plus attorney's fees. The purpose of said amendment will be to position the SHA to purchase smaller units at Old County when they become available in a later phase of the development. J. Howe was asked to confirm that the SHA committed in writing to buy a unit within 2 years of the Comprehensive Permit approval (paragraph 15 of Comprehensive Permit).

**<u>CPA Committee:</u>** S. Cline reported that there is nothing new.

**Housing Trust:** L. Pastuszek reported that the Trust has closed on a single family house off Rte. 20, which will be sold to a first time homebuyer.
