VOTE to share cost for legal opinion with RHSO.

Motion was made seconded and unanimously approved to share 50% of the cost of legal opinion.

## 3. Maynard Road

Project Update –Liz Rust updated the Trust on progress since last meeting. The new developer has purchased the property, and is getting ready to start construction. It is hoped that occupancy will be this summer.
