

Information and Application for Affordable Housing Unit Village at Old County Road

This packet contains specific information for the purchase of a deed restricted unit – Unit 28, the Village at Old County Road development in Sudbury, MA – including the eligibility requirements, the selection process, and an application form. This deed restricted unit will be sold on a First-come First-Served basis. The unit will be shown by appointment to eligible applicants that have submitted a complete application package.

This application is a first step in the purchase process and does not assure you a home. Applicants must secure approval for a mortgage loan, submit evidence of such approval together with the application, and be ready to buy.

Project description

This condo is a rare find. The Villages at Old County Road condominiums consists of 37 townhouses off of Route 20 in Sudbury, a desirable suburban Town, 20 miles west of Boston, with excellent schools. This affordable and attractive unit with 2-bedroom 2 ½ bath unit contains approximately 2,300 square feet of living space on two levels, with a basement. Parking includes a direct entry garage for one car, and space for one car directly in front of it.

The first floor offers an open floor plan with cathedral ceiling and skylight in the family room, a dining room with wainscoting and chair rails, a large and modern eat-in kitchen with breakfast bar peninsula, recessed lighting and wood floors, a private den/study and a half bath. The kitchen and bathrooms have attractive wood floors. The kitchen opens to a private brick patio and yard. The unit comes as is, with a refrigerator, gas range/oven, microwave and dishwasher, and washer/dryer. The second floor offers a Master bedroom suite with generous closets, and large Master bathroom; a lovely 2nd bedroom, a loft area, and another full bath. Washer and dryer hookup are conveniently provided on the second floor, as well as ample closet space. The unit has central AC and the heating system is gas forced hot air.

The purchase price is \$220,652. Owners are required also to pay property taxes, and the 2019 Sudbury tax rate is \$17.91 per \$1,000 of valuation or an estimated monthly amount of \$329. The condominium fee is estimated at \$164 per month, and the Condominium Association has rules and regulations for all owners that describe the operation of the condominium.

The property is part of the MassHousing affordable housing program, and offered at a discounted rate. As such, this and all future sales of the property will be in accordance with those guidelines and Deed Rider to the unit. These properties will be sold below the market price with deed restrictions which protect the property in perpetuity using resale price limitations.

We invite you to read this information and submit an application, with the supplemental information. This application can be downloaded from the RHSO website and can be sent to you upon request.

Lottery Description:

- 1. The applications for this housing opportunity will be generally available, including on-line, in hardcopy at the Regional Housing Services Office and the Sudbury Planning Department, and sent to anyone interested in the opportunity. This opportunity will be advertised and communicated through local, regional and state channels.
- 2. Applications are to be submitted with all required information in hardcopy to the address above. No emailed or faxed applications will be accepted. Applicants are encouraged to complete the checklist as an aide to the process.

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- 3. The maximum gross household income will be verified and compared to the HUD 2019 published income limits. 1 person- \$62,450, 2 person- \$71,400, 3 person- \$80,300 4 person- \$89,200, 5 person- \$96,350, 6 person \$103,500.
- 4. The household assets will be verified and compared to the \$75,000 maximum asset limit. Assets include but are not limited to all cash, cash in savings accounts, checking accounts, certificates of deposit, bonds, stocks, cash value of retirement accounts, value of real estate holdings and other capital investments. Equity from the sale of any home will be included with other household assets that cannot exceed a total of \$75,000.
- 5. Eligible applicants must be a First-time Homebuyer. This is further defined as a household that has not owned a home within three years preceding the application, with the exception of displaced homemaker, single parents and senior households (at least one household member is 55 or over).
 - A displaced homemaker is an individual who is an adult, who has owned a home only with a spouse, who is legally separated from a spouse, and who does not currently own the home previously owned with a spouse.
 - Single parents are individuals who owned a home with his or her partner or resided in a home owned by the partner and is a single parent (is unmarried or legally separated from a spouse and either has 1 or more children of whom the individual has custody or joint custody, or is pregnant);
 - Additional exceptions are made for households that owned a principal residence not permanently affixed to a permanent foundation.
- 6. Once the application is submitted and deemed complete by the Resale Agent, then the Resale Agent will determine initial eligibility and the applicant will be notified of their eligibility.
- 7. As the Monitoring Agent, the Town will then review the buyer's income, assets and other criteria before the buyer can proceed to purchase the unit. Approved applicants will be given 2 days to agree to purchase the unit before the next person can be offered the opportunity.
- 8. Upon the satisfaction of the qualification requirements of both the Resale and Monitoring Agent, the qualified buyer is then able to move forward and execute the Purchase and Sale with the seller.
- 9. All potential buyers are required to attend a First Time Homebuyer Class prior to closing. Organizations offering these classes can be found at www.chapa.org.
- 10. The State programs and bank products have specific closing and financing requirements. Current mortgage requirements include:
 - The loan must have a fair and fixed interest rate through the full term of the mortgage.
 - FHA Mortgages and family mortgages are not approved for this project.
 - The loan can have no more than 2 points.
 - The buyer must provide a down payment of at least 3%; half must come from the buyer's own funds.
 - Non-household members shall not be permitted as co-signers of the mortgage.
 - The buyer may not pay more than 38% of their monthly income for monthly housing costs.
 - Loans from non-institutional lenders will not be accepted.
- 11. The Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination in housing because of Race or color, National origin, Religion, Sex, Familial status. An applicant who believes that they have been discriminated against in the buyer selection and sales process may contact: the Massachusetts Commission Against Discrimination; and/or the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- 12. Disabled persons are entitled to request reasonable accommodation of rules, policies, or services, or reasonable modification of housing.
- 13. Resale process: The Monitoring Agent, Town of Sudbury, has up to 90 days after you give notice of your intention to sell the home to close on a sale to an Eligible Purchaser. If you attempt to sell or transfer the home without complying with the Deed Rider requirements, the Monitoring Agents may, among their other rights, void any contract for such sale or the sale itself.
