- **b)** Confidentiality: suggest that we consider expanding the opening statement of our policy (2003) to site the law on which it is based and to clarify the scope of its application. The clarification does not alter the existing policy. See attached draft. The proposed wording is in the opening statement. It is in **bold**.
- c) Building Projects: will begin drafting RFP for painting/gutters of 19th century wing.
- d) **Delivery:** volume versus vendor's capabilities is still a concern.
- **e) Travel Reimbursement:** this has not received attention in almost 20 years. Reimbursement has been sporadic at best. Currently, a few staff members are required to attend more MLN meetings than in the past. For this reason, and because of gas prices, I will be more attentive to handling reimbursements.
- **f) Fourth of July:** we close the weekend of it –sometimes hard to determine when July 4th is Wednesday. This year it is on a Tuesday. We will be closed the Saturday and Sunday before July 4. I am checking with the Town to determine if other departments will be closed on Monday.
- g) New Remote Database: we are adding a new remote database that provides access to more than 150 practice tests including SAT, GRE, Civil Service and others. The software grades the results. We are sending out publicity to the schools, paper and so on.
- h) ESL Program: a Sudbury resident has met with me on several occasions to discuss the possibility of offering an ESL program for Sudbury adults. The person is a retired Sudbury teacher who has done this type of volunteer teaching with Framingham agencies. I may have more background information for the meeting.
