Spring Fair will be held in conjunction with the Mammography Van at Haskell Field. The Fair will run from 10am–12pm and the Dana Farber Van will be doing Mammograms from 8:00am–3:30pm. From 10am-12:00pm community partners will be promoting wellness in Sudbury. There will be a Breast Health Educator from Dana-Farber Cancer Institute on-site. Emerson Hospital will offer Blood Pressure monitoring and unveiling their Sun Screen Station. In conjunction with Impact Melanoma, the Sudbury Health Dept. will have a Facial Scanner on site to determine skin damage from the sun. Stop by to learn about great health-related resources, pick up some health give away items and get tips on staying well through spring and summer. Featured Town of Sudbury Departments: Health Dept., Medical Reserve Corps, Police Dept., MCDC, Senior Center, Park & Rec., Fire Dept. and the Goodnow Library.

The Mammography Van is the only mobile mammography program in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. It provides digital screening mammograms and (depending upon availability) breast education to women 40 years of age and older. Skilled mammography technologists from Dana-Farber perform the exams, and images are interpreted by board certified radiologists with extensive experience dedicated to mammography.

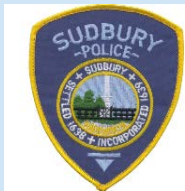
