Capital Project Planning – Upper Featherland Renovation – Planned. Meeting with Jody Kablack to look at longterm planning. Williamson Park and Recreation is on the hook for funding of rail trail and sidewalk funding. Griffin – incumbent upon us to not worry about money but have well thought out sensible plan that we can ask for. Funding will come from multiple sources. Williamson – Kablack neglected some things listed under Park and Recreation. Griffin – When would they look for the rest of the design for the rail trail what does that look like? Williamson – FY17 around \$250,000. Griffin-expanded parking at Davis will be looked at to accommodate rail trail parking.

Hockey Rink discussion – table until Mike Ensley is at meeting.

Miscellaneous – Fairbank Community Center

Dick Williamson shared 3 options: Option 1 = \$15 million, Option 2 = \$16 million, Option 3 = \$17 million. Trying to figure out the timeline and how that effects capital planning on the current building as some items need to be repaired and/or replaced. Commission asked Dick if he could arrange for Mike Melnick from the permanent building committee to attend our next commission meeting.
