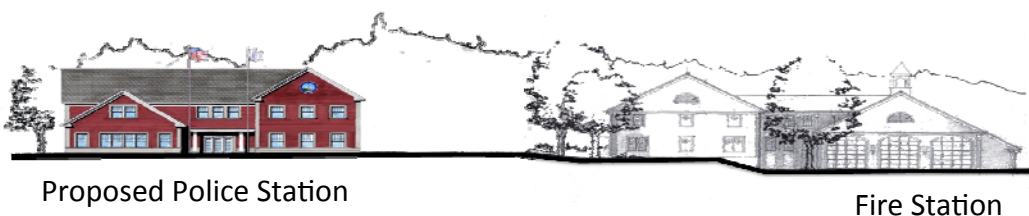


CONCEPTUAL DESIGN

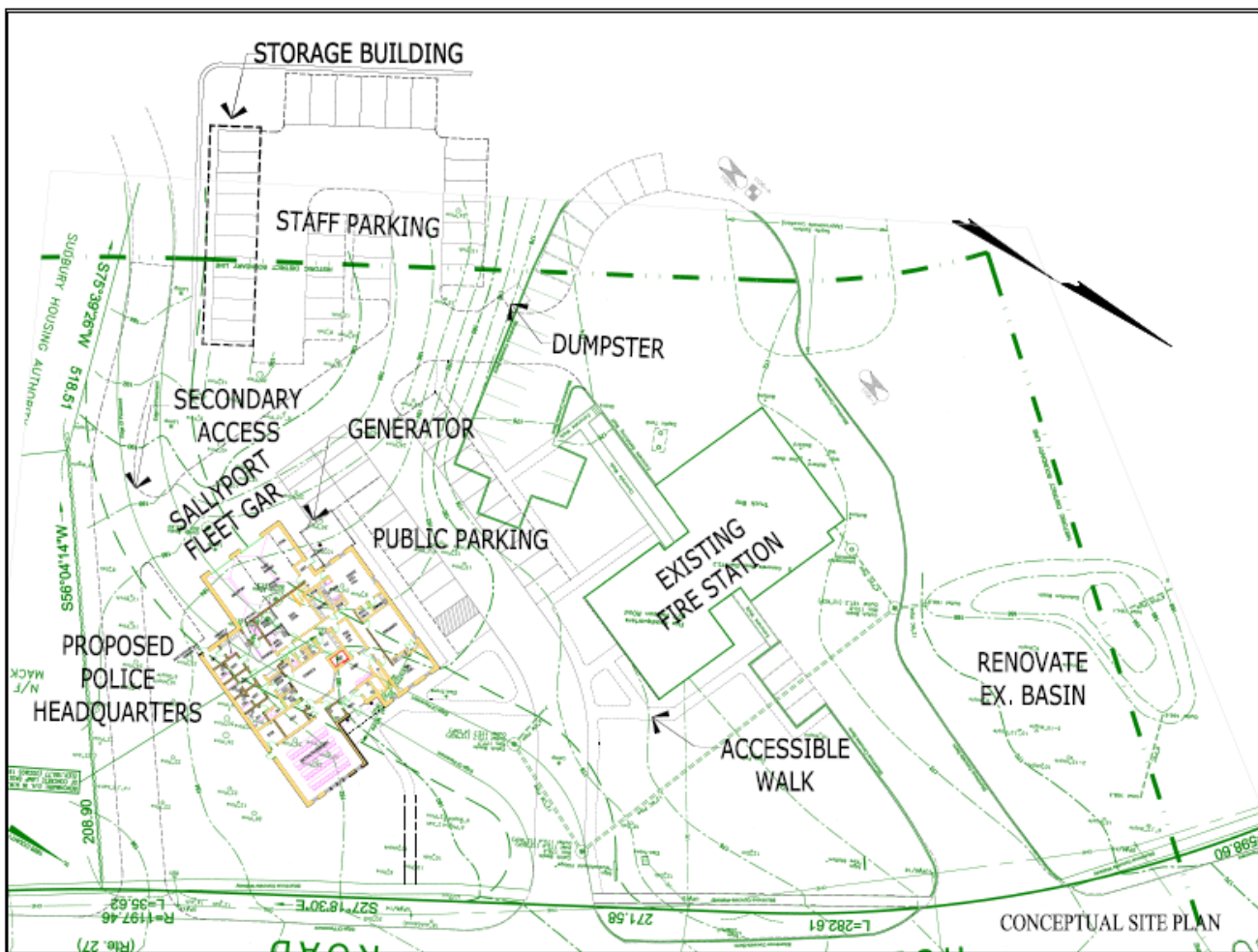
PROJECT MISSION:
