**Construction Cost: estimated \$7,200,000 (funds approved for design in 2013)**

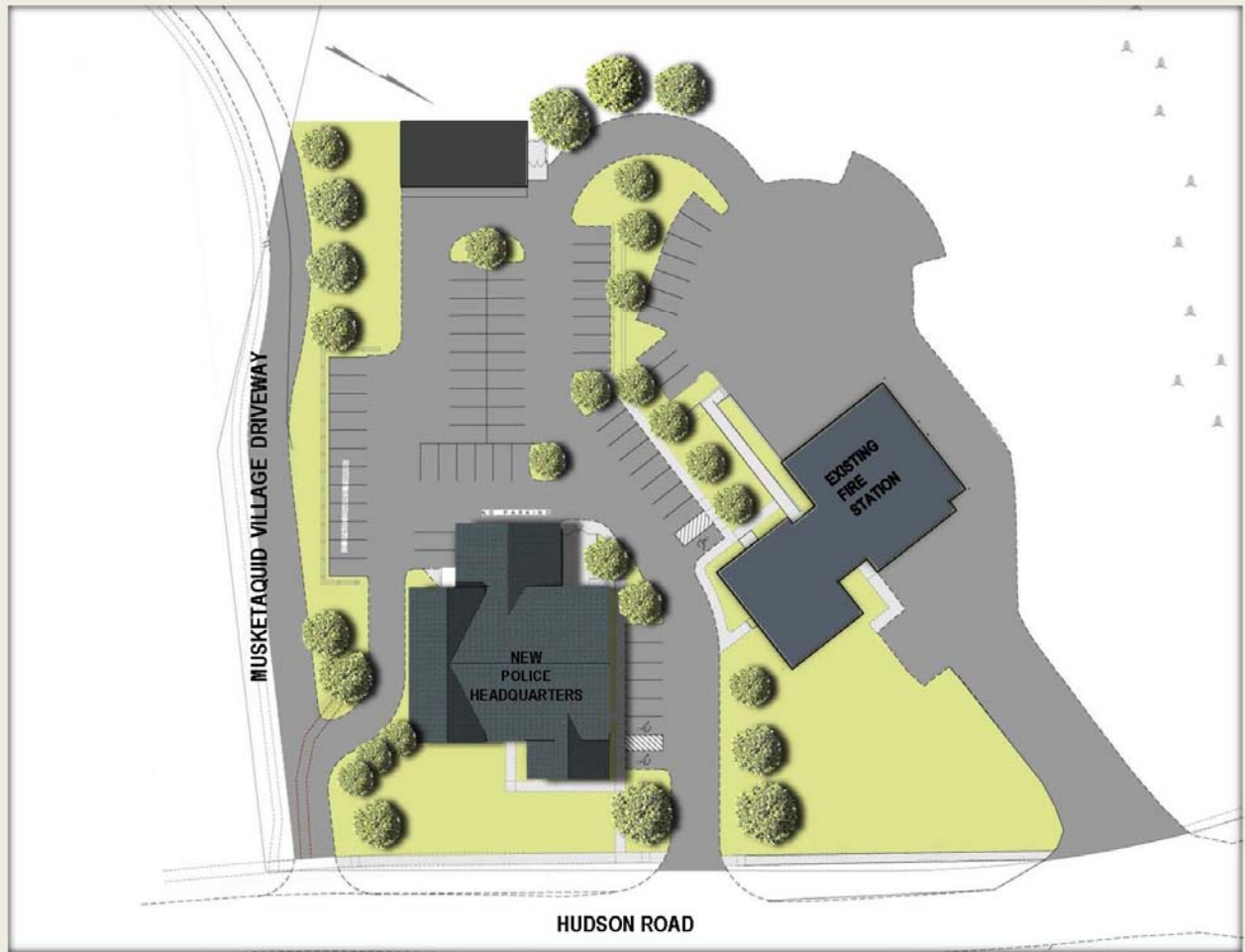
**Includes: Construction, Site Work, Furnishings, Equipment**
