

At a legal meeting of the qualified voters of the Town of Sudbury,

held May 7, 2014 the following business was transacted under

<u>Article 32 – COMMUNITY PRESERVATION FUND – BRUCE</u> <u>FREEMAN RAIL TRAIL DESIGN</u>

MODERATOR DECLARED VOTED BY WELL MORE THAN A MAJORITY:

To appropriate the sum of \$150,000 of Community Preservation Act funds from FY15 Revenue, as recommended by the Community Preservation Committee, for the purpose of preparing the 25% design plan for the full 4.4 mile Bruce Freeman Rail Trail in Sudbury to MA DOT standards, and to redirect remaining funds in the amount of \$27,684.65 from Article 24 of the 2007 Annual Town Meeting (BFRT Base Map) and \$24,807.50 from Article 27 of the 2009 Annual Town Meeting (BFRT Concept Plan) to be used for this purpose. All appropriations will be allocated to the Recreation category.
