# 275 Old Lancaster Road (Assessor's Map H08-0049) – Minor Site Plan Review Modification

DPW Director Dan Nason was in attendance to discuss the matter with the Planning Board.

Board Members reviewed aspects of modifications to the plan. Mr. Duchesneau explained that the gates at the DPW site would be open during business hours only.
