Updates

Harvester - will be available starting July 29, to harvest Carding Mill Pond and then Stearns Mill Pond. Frank will follow-up with Bill Place about repairing Stearns Mill Pond's dam since repairs need to be made before using the harvester. In addition to repairing the dam, the Hop Brook Protection Association must decide what to do with the harvested plant material since the garlic farmer who previously took it no longer leases land near the pond. Frank informed the committee that Grist Mill Pond may need to be harvested in 2014.

Pull-a-thon - was successful; more than forty people participated and pulled approximately nine cubic yards. Ann Kirk submitted an article about the event to the local paper. The committee discussed sending thank-you notes to participants, and mentioning that the PWC is seeking new members.
