Nashoba 2014 Elementary School Program FAQS

1. When does the program start?

The program begins on Tuesday, January 7th or Wednesday, January 8th (depending on the day you are registered for) and runs for six weeks ending on Tuesday, February 11th or Wednesday, February 12th.

2. How do I register?

Registration can be done at **www.recreation.sudbury.ma.us** or complete the registration form on the back and mail to 40 Fairbank Road or register in person at the Atkinson Pool front desk. **Make checks payable to the Town of Sudbury.**

3. When does registration begin and end?

<u>SPACE IS UNLIMITED</u> but you are encouraged to sign up early! Registration will begin on Wednesday, October 16th at 9:00am and end at 4:00pm on Wednesday, December 18th. No registrations will be processed after this time.

4. Who is eligible for lessons?

Students must be in Grades K-5 to participate in skiing, Grades 1-5 for snowboarding, no exceptions!

5. How do participants get to Nashoba?

The Recreation Department **WILL NOT** be providing transportation to and from Nashoba Valley. It is up to the participant to make their own arrangements for transportation.

6. What time does the program start?

Lessons will start at 5:30pm sharp. Lessons last for one hour. You have the option to free ski or snowboard <u>either before the lesson (starting at 1:00pm) or after the lesson (until 10pm.)</u>
Participants not taking lessons may ski or snowboard between 1-10:00pm.

7. How do they know what class to put my child in?

Students are evaluated on their first day of class. Students are divided by both age and ability. Participants from other towns will be taking lessons at the same time; Sudbury participants will not all be grouped together. Nashoba recommends that students arrive 15 minutes in advance of their first lesson. **Please designate a meeting place with your child for the end of lessons.**

8. Is rental equipment available?

Yes, equipment is available as a complete package only. All rented equipment will stay at Nashoba during the duration of the program. A fitting date is set for **Tuesday, December 17th**. Drop in **between 7:00pm and 8:00pm** at the Fairbank Community Center, 40 Fairbank Road. If you cannot make the fitting date, please make arrangements to be fitted at Nashoba Valley before lessons start. Helmets are available for rental or purchase at the rental fitting or at Nashoba.

9. What if the program is cancelled due to bad weather?

Extra days will be added on if school or the ski area is closed. The program will be cancelled at the discretion of Nashoba Valley or the Recreation Department and a determination will be made by 1:00pm that day. Please call **(978) 639-3233** after 1:00pm for the decision.

10. How does Nashoba know who is in the program?

All participants must wear a designated badge every time they are at the mountain. Badges will be available for pick-up in late December and must be picked up at the recreation office before the program begins. Badges cost \$5 to be replaced.

11. Can someone else use my badge or can I use it on a different day?

Substitutions are prohibited. Participants may not transfer the use of their lift, lesson, or rental services to any other person or day. Misuse will result in loss of privileges.

12. What if my child misses a session?

Sorry, no refunds will be given and no make up dates can be added for missing a day (unless the program is cancelled due to the weather.)
