**I. School Committee Report**

**A. Bill Schedule**

**B. Policy 4.4.9: Wellness: Nutrition and Physical Activity – 2<sup>nd</sup> Vote**

**VOTED:** On a motion by Susan Iuliano, seconded by Jeff Beeler, to accept Policy 4.4.9: Wellness: Nutrition and Physical Activity as presented. The vote was 4-0 in favor.

**C. Van Driver/Crossing Guard Compensation**

Mary Will presented a proposed salary increase for Van Drivers and Crossing Guards.

**VOTED:** On a motion by Rich Robison, seconded by Susan Iuliano, to accept the proposed salary schedule for Van Drivers and Crossing Guards. The vote was 4-0 in favor.

**D. Ratification of Custodial Contract**

Mary Will presented the proposed agreement between the Sudbury School Committee and the Sudbury Education Association Custodial Employees.

**VOTED:** On a motion by Jeff Beeler, seconded by Susan Iuliano, to approve the proposed agreement between the Sudbury School Committee and the Sudbury Education Association Custodial Employees. The vote was 4-0 in favor.

The Superintendent presented a draft of a position paper on early childhood education for discussion purposes. The Committee discussed issues such as educational needs, full day kindergarten, space, and extended day. The Superintendent will re-work the draft for the next meeting.

**A. Middle School Student Activity Fund Adjustment**

Mary Will explained the need to increase the limit of the Curtis Middle School Student Activity Checking Account by \$20,000 to cover costs of the year, including field trips and the yearbook.

**VOTED:** On a motion by Susan Iuliano, seconded by Jeff Beeler, to increase the maximum balance that may be on deposit for the Curtis Middle School Student Activity Checking Account from \$20,000 to \$40,000. The vote was 4-0 in favor.
