Open Forum I

I. School Committee Report

A. Bill Schedule

A bill schedule was presented.

II. Superintendent's Report

Recognition

There were no recognitions to report.

A. Senator Pam Resor

Sen. Resor was unable to attend the meeting.

B. Confirm the Approval of an Extra Curricular Position: Elementary Math Club Advisor & Middle School Math Team Advisor

VOTED: On a motion by Rich Robison, seconded by Jeff Beeler, to approve the SEA Letter of Agreement approving the creation of, and setting the compensation for, the Elementary Math Club Advisor and Middle School Math Team Advisors as presented. The vote was 3-0 in favor.

C. Early Childhood Revolving Account

The Superintendent explained that the spending limit on the existing Preschool Revolving Fund needs to be increased in order to expend the funds remaining in the account.

VOTED: On a motion by Rich Robison, seconded by Jeff Beeler, to approve an increase in the limit of the Early Childhood Revolving Fund, established under G.L. Chapter 44, Section 53E 1/2, from \$204,000 to \$250,000. The vote was 3-0 in favor.

VOTED: On a motion by Jeff Beeler, seconded by Rich Robison, to approve the minutes of the May 23, 2007 Regular Session as amended. The vote was 3-0 in favor.

As outlined in the Personnel Packet. The Superintendent noted the resignation of Jane Hundley, Social

Studies Curriculum Coordinator, who has taken a position in Burlington. He also noted the resignation of van driver Laura Jane Taylor.

Member's Forum

Rich Robison explained that he needs all members' input into the Superintendent's evaluation by the end of this week. The Subcommittee will meet by the end of June, and the process should be completed by the July meeting.

Several members have a conflict with the date of the July meeting. It will be changed to July 5.

Mary Mahoney requested that, when speaking to legislative representatives, a suggestion be made to move the MCAS schedule to the end of June.

Jeff Beeler advised improved communication to parents and community members regarding the role of the School Committee. This could include easier access to information on the website and inclusion in parent and student handbooks.

The Committee discussed possible topics of conversation with legislative representatives including Benefit & Pension Reform, Universal Preschool, and Funding Formula Reform.

VOTED: On a motion by Rich Robison, seconded by Jeff Beeler, to adjourn to Executive Session, not to return to Open Session, for purposes of Potential Litigation. The vote was 3-0 in favor. The time was 8:45 p.m.
