# **Eversource 115-kV Project Update**

#### Greetings!

This is an update on activities related to the Eversource 115-kilovolt (kV) Underground Transmission Project. Eversource is aiming to place the transmission line in service in the coming months which will conclude the Eversource portion of the work in the corridor. Other restoration activities will be ongoing throughout the rest of 2024. From there, Eversource will turn over work in the inactive MBTA corridor to the <a href="Massachusetts">Massachusetts</a>
<a href="Department of Conservation and Recreation">Department of Conservation and Recreation</a> (DCR) who will install the new shared-use rail trail.

#### **Work Hours**

- **Sudbury** Approved work hours are 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Friday. During the cable installation process, crews are working from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Saturday. All other activities in the corridor will happen from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- **Hudson** Approved work hours are 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Friday. Crews are working in the Hudson roads from 7a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Friday. During cable installation, crews are active from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Saturday.

Occasional activities may extend beyond the approved hours, due to unforeseen circumstances, based on approval from local officials. Crews work between manholes (MHs) placed along the project route. For a closer look, view the project map.

#### **Hudson Activities**

- Friday, September 27, crews will be completing final surveys of the roadway in Hudson, which is expected to last several hours.
- Starting soon, crews will be installing crosswalk signal infrastructure at both Main Street and Wilkins Street, where the MBTA corridor intersects.
- One crew will be working at Hudson Light & Power to excavate and install duct bank.
- In the inactive MBTA corridor, crews are installing loam and seed that is part of the restoration effort.

### **Sudbury Activities**

- Over the next few weeks, crews will be installing plantings throughout the corridor in Sudbury. Installations will occur between the Sudbury Substation and the Town line.
- Starting soon, as early as October 10, crews will begin restoring a water line
  underground on Boston Post Road, between Maple Ave and Station Road. Work in
  this area is expected to last two weeks and will be followed by final road restoration.
  Once this activity is finished, crews will complete the final road restoration at other
  road crossings in Sudbury, including Union Ave, Horse Pond Rd, and Dutton Rd.

\*Due to the complexities of underground construction and weather, the two-week schedule described above is subject to change.
