The Framingham Salvation Army's Good Neighbor Energy Fund (GNEF)

The Massachusetts Good Neighbor Energy Fund is available to any Massachusetts resident who, because of temporary financial difficulty, cannot meet a month's energy expense and is not eligible for state or federal energy assistance. Income must fall between 60 and 80 percent of the state's median income levels. The Fund pays utility bills directly and it takes about 4 weeks for bills to be paid once approved.
