- Create your own circle art and fill it in using words and images to respond to the questions above. You may make your circle out of items you have at your house: Cut up an old box and add photos, words, drawings, clippings, or anything else that you'd like to include.
  - If you'd like a pre-cut 20-inch cardboard circle, they are plenty available to the general public in a bin on the porch of the **Grange Hall** (326 Concord Road in Sudbury).
  - If you have financial need for other art supplies and/or do not have transporation to pick up a circle, please contact the Sudbury Neighbor Brigade (SudburyMA@neighborbrigade.org) and they can deliver markers, crayons, scissors, glue, and a cardboard circle.

To share virtually, upload a photo of your completed circle to tinyurl.com/thecircleprojectsudbury.

Place your completed circle in your yard or hang in your window as long as you like, but particularly **July 3-5**.

Drive around town July 4th weekend to see the beautiful circles your neighbors have made.

Drop off your circle art to the bin on the porch of the **Grange Hall** (326 Concord Road in Sudbury) any time from **July 6-10** to be included in a community installation at the Wayside Inn (date for display to be determined!)
