

About the Performers



Lola Dance features Polynesian dancing from the islands of Hawaii (where it is called "Hula"), Tahiti, and the Maori of New Zealand. Hula, a dance form which dramatizes a chant or song, was developed in the Hawaiian Islands by the Polynesians who originally settled there.



Fikira Music is a seven piece Afro-Jazz band lead by Manavihare Fiaindratovo (Mimy), a hand percussionist from Madagascar. Influenced by traditional Malagasy music, jazz harmonies, and the diverse musical backgrounds of band members from Madagascar,

Latin America, and the US, the band's mainly original repertoire explores the richness of traditional Malagasy culture, incorporating rhythms from the Atandroy people into western harmonies, using modern instrumentation and the free improvisation of jazz.



Royal Scottish Country Dance Society of Boston combines energetic jigs and reels with the elegance of the Scottish strathspey. Country dance took the form of the

traditional English contra dance, while the steps reflect both the highland and continental aspects of the Auld Alliance between the Scottish and French Courts. Originating in the Scottish court of the mid-1700's, it quickly spread to village halls and barns, captivating all levels of Scottish society. The international chapter of RSCDS was established in 1923 in Edinburgh to protect and promote the standards of Scottish country dancing; the Boston group was the first overseas branch,



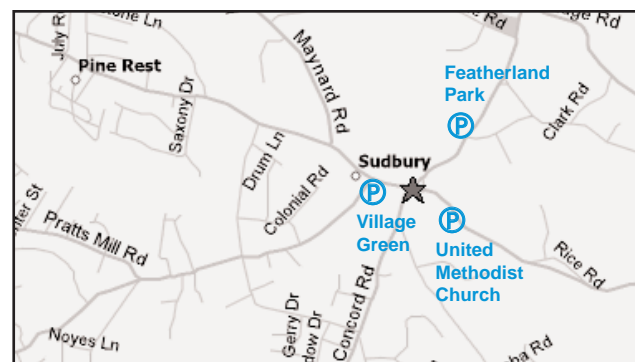
Highland Dance Boston specializes in the traditional and contemporary dances of Scotland, such as the Sword Dance and Argyle Broadwords. They are accompanied with music by a traditional Scottish bagpiper.



Branches Pan Groove Steel Band strives to preserve, promote and expose youths, adults and families to the cultural and educational aspects of Caribbean Music in

the form of the steel drum, the only acoustic instrument invented in the 20th century created from oil drums left behind by the US military on the islands of Trinidad and Tobago. The band currently has around 60 members, ranging from age 7 to 60.

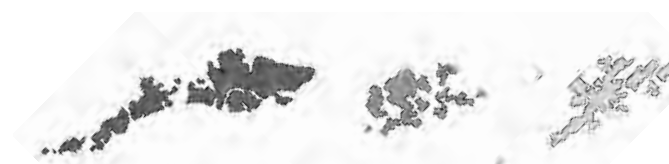
