

OCTOBER 15, 2018 SPECIAL TOWN MEETING Article 2:

Broadacres Farm

Protecting our open space, character and history

Broadacres Farm is an active 34-acre horse farm with stables, pasture, indoor arena, and riding fields located on both sides of scenic Morse Road. The property has abundant natural and cultural resources, is connected to other Townowned properties, and offers potential for recreational use. It is a priority for protection identified in the 2009-2015 Open Space and Recreation Plan and the Heritage Landscape Inventory of 2006.

A purchase & sale agreement has been negotiated for the purchase of the property. The total cost of the acquisition is \$5.5 million. The Community Preservation Committee agreed to fund Phase 1 of the purchase, committing almost \$2 million in CPA funds, thus reducing the amount to be borrowed to approx. \$3.5 million.

<u>Town Meeting</u> – October 15: Town meeting vote required to authorize the purchase <u>State Election</u> – November 6: Ballot vote required to authorize spending



The farm abuts:

 Conservation Land
- Featherland Park
- The proposed Bruce Freeman Rail Trail

Creates potential for 50+ acres of contiguous conservation land.
