It is hard to believe that another Camp season is already in the rearview mirror! We had a wonderful summer filled with sunshine, smiles, and spirit. We had 522 campers from Sudbury join us this summer, and were thrilled to welcome 44 Sudbury Resident Scholarship recipients. Enrollment for the summer of 2025 opens later this month, and the process of planning for next summer has already begun!



The closure of our pond due to blue-green algae obviously presented a challenge to our waterfront and programming teams, and we are so grateful for their quick pivot to water games and special weekly activities like a foam pit and a giant waterslide!

The algae bloom unfortunately also impacted our Sudbury Resident Swim program. During the three weeks that we were able to operate, we had a total of 182 swimmers visit the property. As requested by the Select Board last spring, we collected data on both sign ups and swimmers in attendance at each session.
