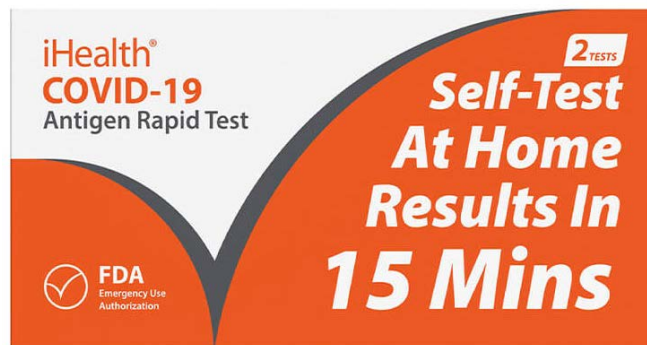

COVID-19 Test Kits

Annual Town Meeting



The Sudbury Board of Health recommends testing for COVID-19 prior to attending the Annual Town Meeting at L-SRHS Auditorium on May 2, 2022.

TESTING CAN BE DONE ON SUNDAY, MAY 1 OR ON MONDAY, MAY 2.

The CDC recommends that if the community level where you live is Medium (this is the current Middlesex County Community Level) and if you are at risk for severe illness that you talk to your healthcare provider about wearing masks indoors in public.
