

Library of Things

The Library of Things is a collection of non-traditional items. Library patrons are required to check out and return Library of Things items to the Reference Desk at the Goodnow Library in Sudbury, MA.

Borrowers must be 18 years of age or older. A valid Minuteman Library Network card in good standing is required to borrow a Thing.

Limits

Patrons are limited to THREE Library of Things checkouts per month. Due to high demand, mobile hotspots and individual Roku streaming services are limited to ONE checkout per household per month.

Borrowing periods

Items may be checked out for up to 14 days with no renewals; patrons may choose the number of days they wish to borrow the item when they place their reservation.

Proper Use and Liability

- The borrower is responsible for the item and will be billed:
 - if the item is not returned by the due date,
 - for reasonable repair or replacement costs associated with damage or loss of items and/or peripherals due to neglect or abuse.
- A list of replacement costs is maintained by the Library and is available upon request.
- Goodnow Library is not responsible for any injury, loss, or damage that may occur from use of any item.
- It is the borrower's responsibility to protect against loss. Staff will inspect each item upon return. Borrowers are expected to return the item with all parts, components and carriers to the Reference Desk.
- Library of Things items may not be returned in the book drops.
- Patrons will be responsible for any missing parts or damage to each item until it has been checked in and found to be complete and in working order.
- **Do not change the settings of any Library of Things item.**
- **Mobile Hotspots only: For US use only. Patrons will be responsible for any roaming charges incurred.**
- **The library reserves the right to turn off a hotspot or Roku streaming service if it is not returned within 3 days past the due date.**

Suspension of Borrowing Privileges

- **In order to guarantee that items in the Library of Things collection are available to all our patrons in a fair and equitable manner, Goodnow Library reserves the right to suspend the borrowing privileges of patrons who repeatedly do not return items on time.**
