# MAPC/Sudbury Taxi Ride Program 

## Analysis to Date (January 2021)

## Registrants

Of 78 people registered, $90 \%$ are 50 years of age or older; $42 \%$ are persons with a disability (temporary or permanent); and 42\% are financially vulnerable. Note that these are overlapping categories. There is one active veteran registered and riding.

## Destinations

As expected, the majority of rides (48\%) are to healthcare appointments; additionally, $7 \%$ are for prescription or other medical supply shopping. Grocery shopping accounted for $24 \%$ of rides, work for 12\%, and "social" (a miscellaneous category) for 9\%.

## Costs

The graph illustrates the number of rides by cost groupings. For Tommy’s Taxi, nearly $3 / 4$ of rides cost between $\$ 30$ and $\$ 79$. For JFK sedan (not including WAV), $60 \%$ of rides cost between $\$ 10$ and $\$ 49$ (44\% between $\$ 30$ and $\$ 79$ ). JFK provided 21 WAV trips at $\$ 3,780$ total.
