

Thank you for being a participant of the Go Sudbury Taxi program. We are pleased that many of you have been accessing this program for your medical appointment needs in Sudbury, surrounding towns, and especially in the Boston area. As you know, this program is funded by a combination of grants and town funding.

Due to the high cost to sustain the program, the transportation committee will be asking you to use the Sudbury Connection Van when your appointments are in one of the following locations: Sudbury, Framingham, Marlborough, Concord, Wayland and Maynard.

Sudbury Connection Van Hours and Eligibility:

Monday through Friday, five (5) days a week (excluding holidays) from 8:30 AM – 4:00 PM (first ride at 8:45 AM; last ride starts at 3:30 PM).

Van Service is available to Sudbury residents 60 and older and residents who are 18 and older who are living with a disability.

Applying for and Using the Service:

When your application is approved you will set up a debit account with the MWRTA for van fees. Van fees are \$1.00 in town; \$2.00 for out of town for a one-way ride and are deducted when you take a ride.

Van ride reservations are made at least 48 business hours in advance by contacting the MWRTA Reservation Center at 508-820-4650.
