- 10-20 year outlook (2040)

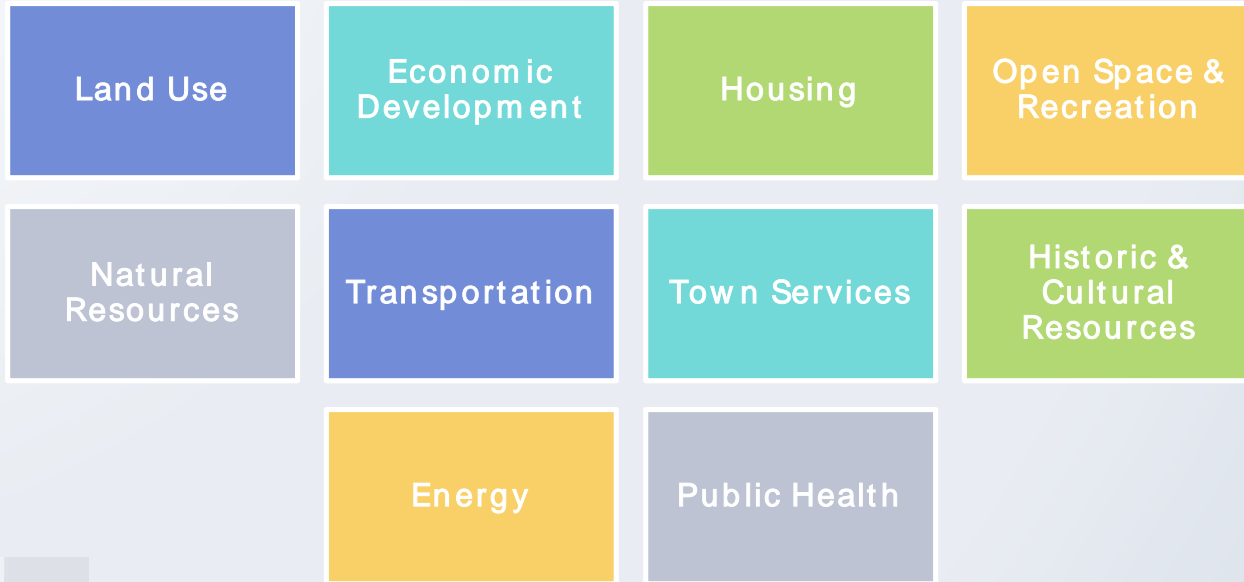


How is the Master Plan used?

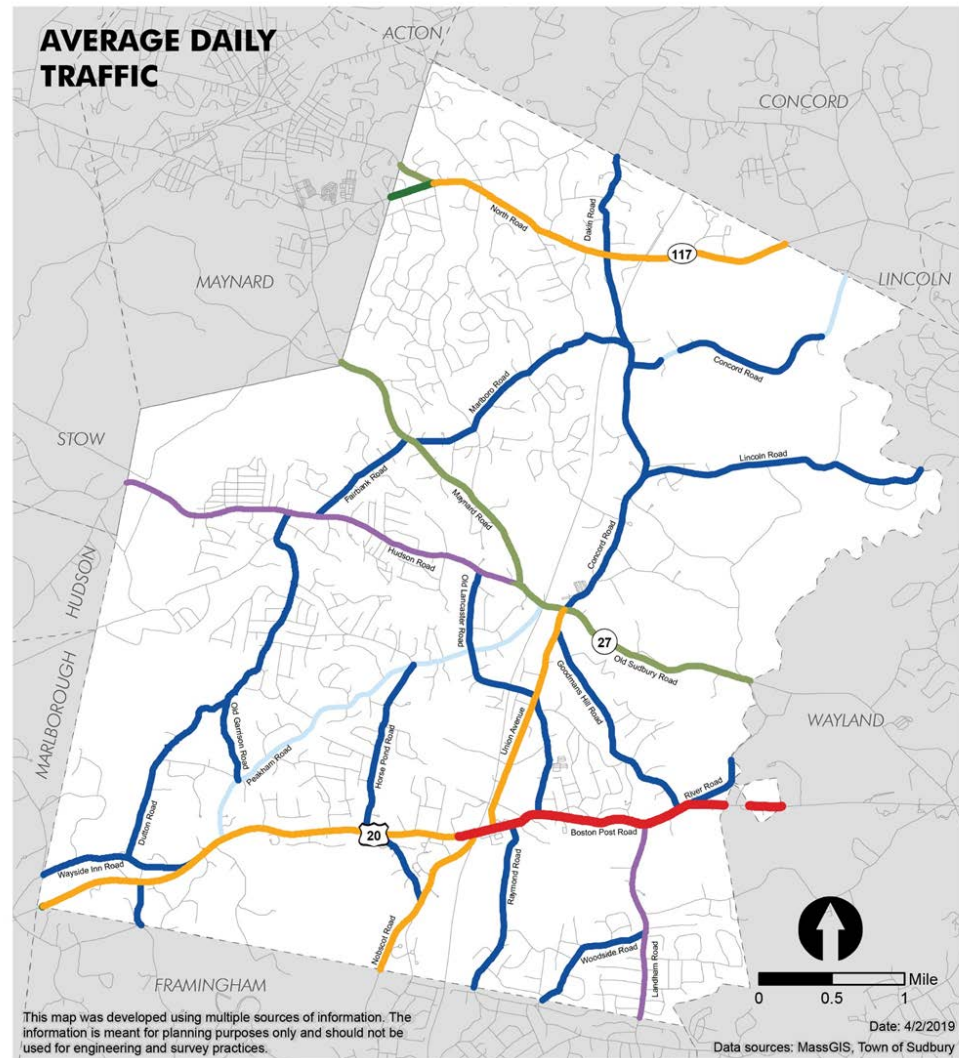
Traffic Volumes

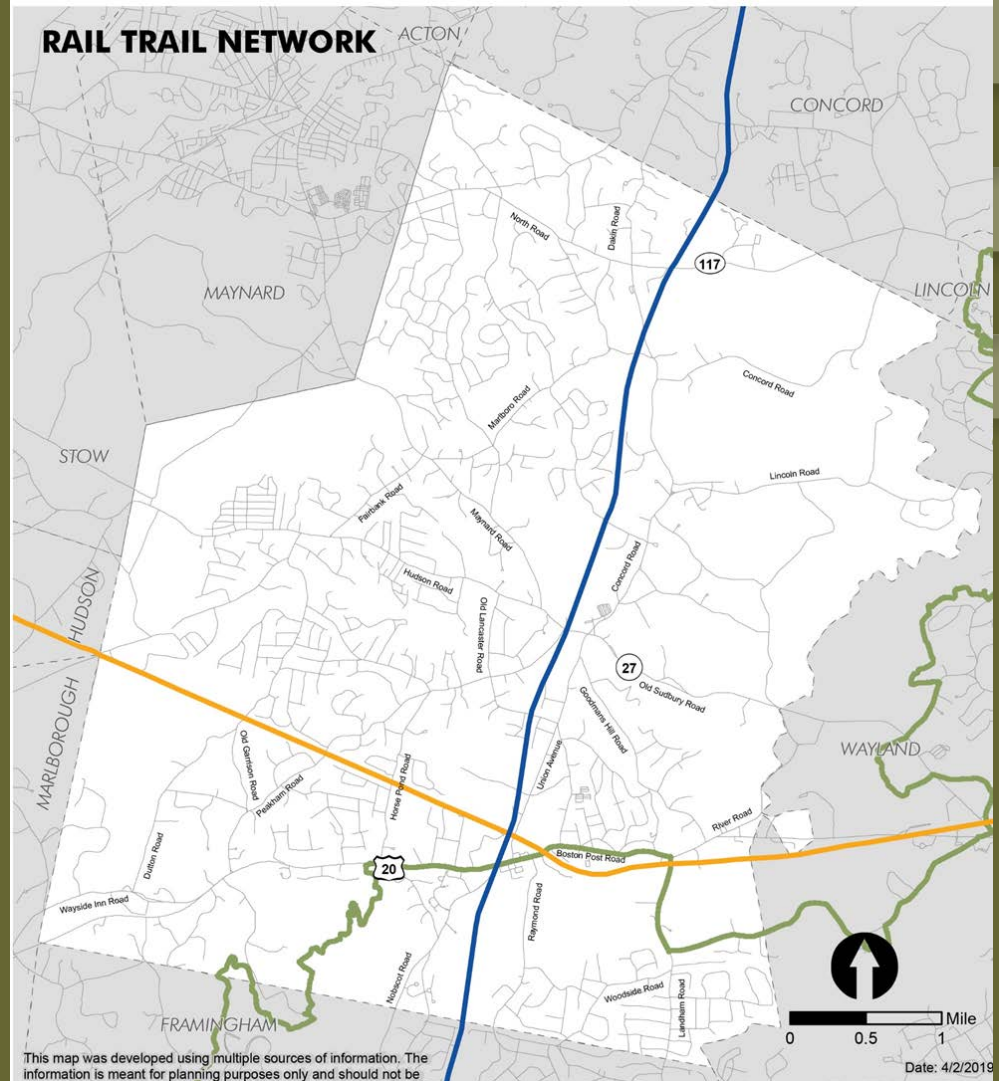

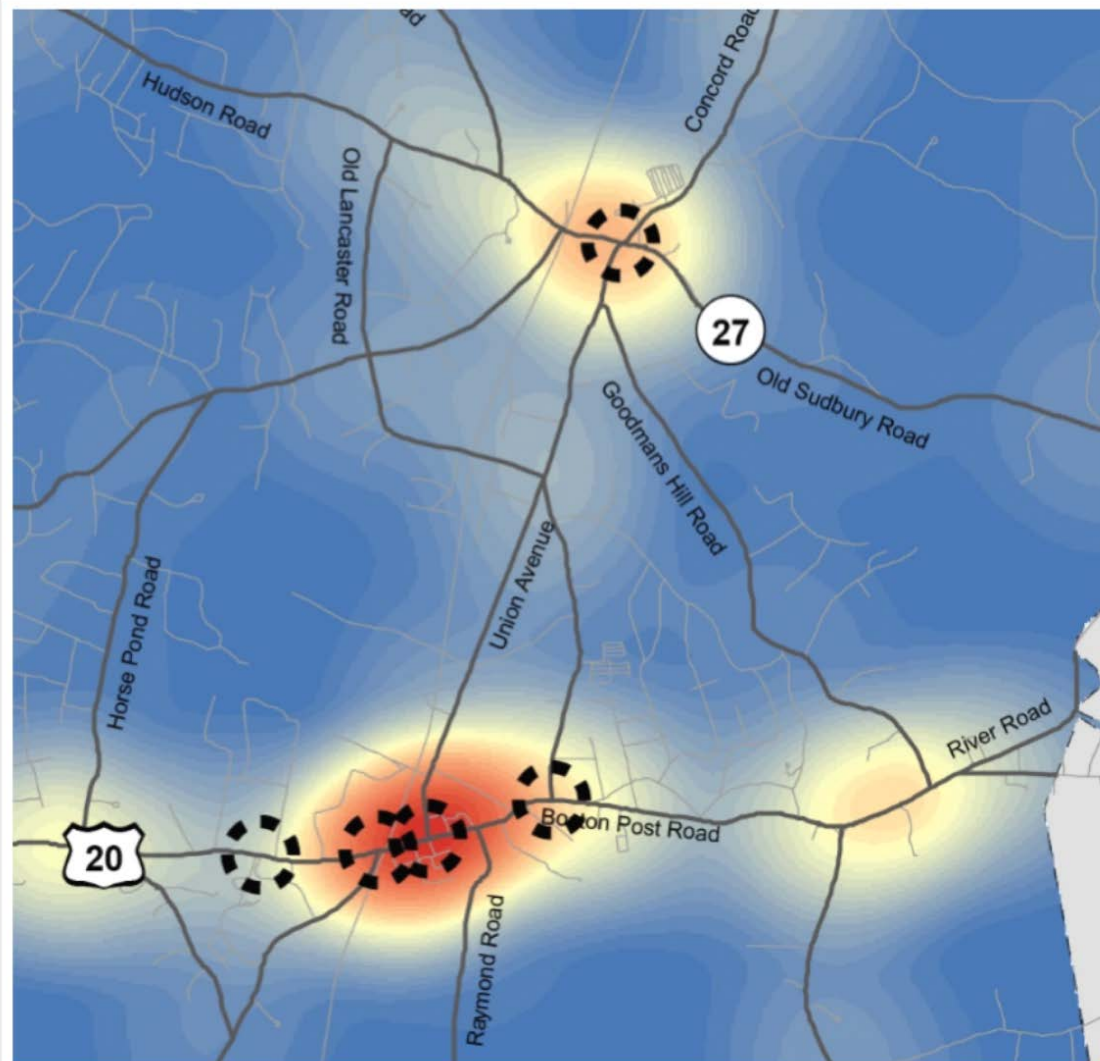
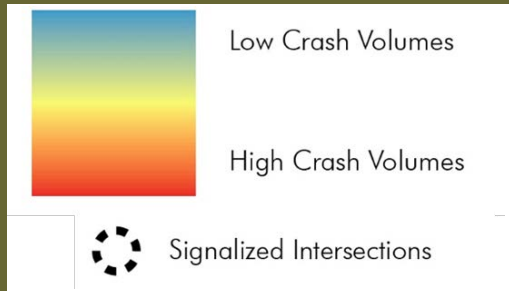


Walkways and Connectivity

What we've heard

- ❑ Traffic congestion
 - Concerns about development in town and next door
- ❑ Limited public transit options
 - Transit network not well linked regionally
- ❑ Lack of options leave certain residents behind
 - Seniors, disabled, lower income

What we've heard

- ❑ Walking and biking safety, lack of ADA accessibility
- ❑ Limited resources available for maintenance of existing walkways and creation of additional walkways

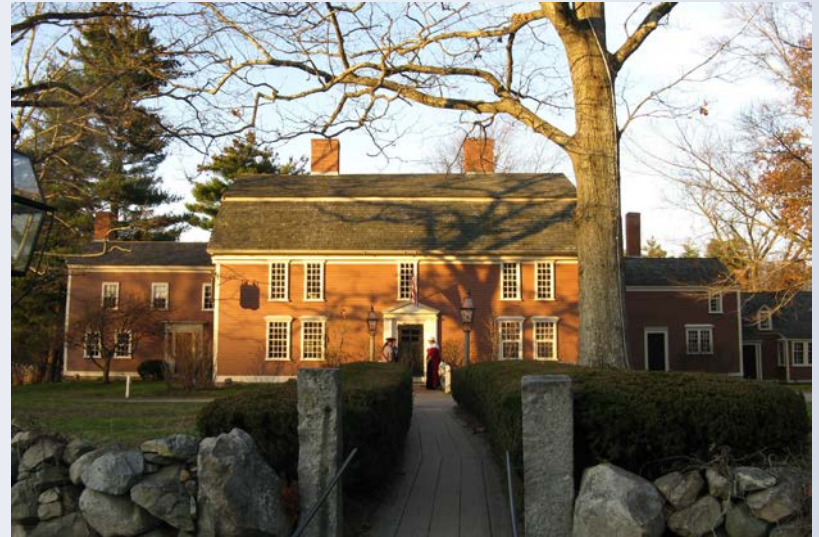
