Lived Experiences Project Sub-Committee Update

After several months of hard work, the Lived Experiences Survey was launched on 5/2! The survey is located on our website: sudburylivedexperiences.org. Before being launched, feedback on the survey was sought from the full DEI Commission and the Commission on Disability. Flyers with a QR code to the survey were printed and distributed at Town Meeting. Our next sub-committee meeting on 5/11 will focus on outreach. To begin our outreach planning, a list of community organizations/groups was developed and distributed to the full Commission. Commission members are being asked to sign up and make contact with at least 3 organizations/groups by 5/14 in order to promote the Lived Experiences survey. The sub-committee can provide sample messages/social media posts. We plan to do the initial data analysis/reporting after two months, so we are using a survey closing date of 6/30/22. We look forward to sharing the survey results with the community!
