Opening remarks

Radha reported that Tim Cobbett will take ideas from the joint meeting to the LS history teachers and then to the rest of the teachers and staff. Two main topics: 1) events of April 19, 1775 and July 4th, 1776; 2) thoughts on the 250 years of independence since. Potentially we would offer scholarships and community service.
